

## **1. RECOGNISE DIVERSE LIFE PATHS OF YOUNG PEOPLE**

  - responsibilities
  - financial constraints
  - other pressures

- life-world oriented services and projects to young people.

### **3. PROMOTE SUPPORT STRUCTURES FOR YOUNG PEOPLE**




Member states, services and projects need to
